While the emphasis of the entire course will be on cancer, issues related to benign tumors and diseases in the head and neck (including tumors of the salivary glands, thyroid, parapharyngeal space tumors and other related topics) will be prudently addressed.

Join us in Frankfurt – not only to receive scientific information and training but also to meet old friends or find new ones. We will do our very best to make your stay as comfortable as possible.
