The teaching format will have a well-balanced structure: beginners will benefit from a didactic selection of proven basic techniques, whereas more experienced practitioners will gain insight into advanced procedures.

A special session in each segment will be devoted to non-faculty speakers from Europe and overseas who will demonstrate personal innovations in surgical techniques.

We invite all our colleagues interested in these challenging fields to enjoy what will be an unforgettable learning experience. While attendance of a meeting does not provide a ticket to practice the finer aspects of advanced surgical techniques, we are nonetheless confident that after the meeting, your patients will benefit from your greater knowledge. If you missed this meeting in previous years, please make an effort to be with us in 2011. We have arranged reduced fees for young practitioners, EAFPS members and colleagues coming from East Europe, Africa and South America.
